Caretaker Corner

New Year.

It's that time of year again! Caretaking staff will be busy during the Christmas break undertaking those maintenance works that can't be done while children are on site, and supervising various contractor works. Our dedicated cleaning team will also be undertaking the last deep clean of the calendar year.

With winter now upon us, caretaking staff always have an eye on the weather bulletins. Frost and snow present us with some of the biggest problems in trying to ensure everyone is safe on the site, but we have salt, gritters, and shovels to try and make this possible. The school will always attempt to **open**, even in what might seem to be severe weather conditions - but this is only if we can maintain safety throughout the day and if a) keyholders are able to get to the school and b) a sufficient number of staff are able to get to the school. Personal safety is our key priority

If you wake up to snow, always check on Dojo to see if the school is open. It may, on very rare instances, be necessary to delay the start time to enable the site team to clear pathways.

PE & Sports News

Mr Davies is now the SSCO (School Sports Co-ordinator) for our Hastings area of schools. We have 10 schools in our sports partnership, which is the more than ever and has allowed a wider participation of sport for our area and school. We have already hosted some amazing events including 3 football tournaments and the Sandown Cross Country, which has seen over 150 pupils represent the school. We have Indoor Athletics this month amongst the schools and have created a football league across all the 10 schools to be played throughout the year to see who will be crowned champions.
