As often happens during the half-term breaks there will be contractor works being undertaken during the February recess. The cladding will have new insulation behind it. The works are expected to take 10 weeks in total. We will also have engineers in undertaking our 5-yearly electrical inspection, which is a legal requirement. This will take the whole week.

## PE & Sports News

The children have been fantastic this term learning about Cognitive skills in PE. Ordering instructions and complex movements combined with exploring strategies for attacking and defending.

We were very proud to host the first ever tag rugby tournament at Sandown this term. 7 schools from our local area attended and was aimed at promoting the sport and having fun. Active Hastings and Hastings & Bexhill Rugby Club were both in attendance to help support the children.

We also hosted the Netball Cluster Finals at Sandown for the first time ever and am so proud to say that both of our teams finished first and second overall scoring over 50 goals between them in the tournament. Sandown will now progres to the Area finals on the 9<sup>th</sup> March.

Sandown Cross Country is now scheduled for **23**<sup>rd</sup> **March**, due to the original date colliding with National teacher strikes. The top 10 children for each year group will be selected to take part. Training takes place on Mon, Weds, Fri
