With the winter weather now well and truly with us, caretaking staff need to keep a regular watch on daily weather bulletins. Frost and snow present the school with some of the biggest problems in trying to ensure everyone is safe on the site, but we have salt, gritters, and shovels to try and make this possible. The school will always attempt to open, even in what might seem to be severe weather conditions - but this is only if we can maintain safety throughout the day and if a) keyholders are able to get to the school and b) a sufficient number of staff are able to get to the school. Personal safety is our key priority.

If you wake up to snow, always check on Dojo to see if the school is open. It may, on very rare instances, be necessary to delay the start time to enable the site team to clear pathways.
