
Spellings

Just Around the River Bend



English

This term we will be exploring the text Miu and the Pharaoh. This story is set in Egypt which links to our new History topic of Ancient Egypt.



Geography

In Geography this term we will begin our topic of Rivers. The children will be exploring the curiosity question: What is a river? and learning all about their features.



RSHE

This term, we will be teaching the Year 3 element of our school's Relationships, Sex and Health Education curriculum. Over the course of the topic we will be teaching the children about family stereotypes, how babies grow in the womb and how the female and male body changes on both the inside and the outside as we grow older.

Art

This term in Art the children will be putting their drawing skills to the test in our tone and shading unit.

History

Our History topic is all about Ancient Egypt. The children will begin learning about the importance of the River Nile through the curiosity question: Why did Herodotus call Egypt the 'Gift of the Nile'.

RE

This term we will be returning to Christianity and focusing specifically on Maundy
Thursday and the lead up to Easter. We will also be learning about Passover.



<u>Music</u>

The children will be exploring a song all about the River Nile and using instruments to improvise and compose their own Ancient Egyptian music.

Science

This term, our topic is Forces and Magnets. The children will get to interact with a range of magnets and conduct experiments to observe the ways in which they behave. We are looking forward to a trip to Herstmonceux where the children will get to explore lots of forces in action!



Maths

In Year 3 the children need to know their 3,4 and 8 times tables, building on their existing times table knowledge of their 2's,5's and 10's. Completing the weekly Times Table Rock Stars will help children embed these time tables fluently.

A big focus in Year 3 is learning to tell the time. Throughout the school year, children will challenge themselves to earn their very own watch. They will earn the watch when they can prove that they can confidently tell the time.

In Maths this term we will be learning about length, mass and volume.
