#### Reading



## **Maths**

In Maths this term, the children will be improving their understanding of place value through counting in multiples of 1000, recognising the value of each digit in 4 digit numbers, ordering and comparing numbers beyond 1000 and rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000. They will be using these skills to solve problems using increasingly large positive numbers.

The main focus for Year 4 is ensuring the children are fluent in their times tables. This enables children to access the majority of the maths curriculum. The children will practise these during the school day but it is vital that they are learning them at home too. At the end of Year 4, the children will all take a national times tables check where their fluency will be tested.

# Important Information

#### P.E.

## **Other Areas**

Computing - The children will focus on Online Safety and discuss appropriate rules for keeping themselves safe in the online world and how to resolve any issues they may have.

**RE** - This Term, the children will focus on the life of Abraham.

**History** - We will start our topic on The Romans focusing on our key question: Why did Emperor Claudius invade Britain?

Art - Our focus this term will be perspective drawing. The children will use their skills to create a picture where an object appears larger and closer. They will use their skills to create a picture of a Roman road.
