# Geography & History

In term 3, we will continue to learn about Mexico with a particular focus on earthquakes for Geography. The children will Identify the location and distribution of earthquakes, explain the cause of earthquakes and why Mexico is prone to them and they will empathise with the lives of Mexicans and the impact that earthquakes can have on them.



In History, the children will be learning more about the Maya and answering questions like:

- When so much of the land they lived in was mountain and jungle, how did the Maya manage to become so important?
- Why do historians know so much about ancient Maya society?
- Why did the Ancient Maya leave their jungle cities?
