## History

We are going to be studying WW1. To begin this unit, children enquire into the questions 'Why was the world at war in 1914?'. They will also carry out research and investigate how the First World War affected the lives of the people in Hastings. This will then link back to our topography unit from term 1 and they will answer the question 'How has my local area changed because of World War 1 ?'


# **Your Country Needs You**



### **Science**
