

Science

This term we are learning about Earth in Space! Children will be exploring the distance between the planets, the different phases of the moon, understand how night and day are created and understand how seasons occur.



<u>RE</u>

This term children will be going back to learning about the Islamic religion. Children will learn why Muhammed (PBUH) is important to Muslims, understand how Muhammed's (PBUH) words and actions influence the lives of Muslims and learn how a Muslim prepares to pray.



History and Geography

Our exciting topic is The Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. We will be learning about this for the next 4 terms.



In History, to begin with, the children will be answering key questions like these:

- Why did the Romans leave Britain?
- Who were the Anglo-Saxons and why didn't they choose to live in the towns the Romans left behind?
- How did the lives of Anglo-Saxons change after Ethelbert met Augustine?

In Geography, the children are going to be learning about settlements. This topic links with the history and the children will be answering key questions like these:

- Where would you settle?
- How is land used in settlements?

Computing

On Purple Mash, we will be using the programme 2calculate this term to learn about using spreadsheets. Children will be learning about formulas and all the technical language that will help them with their computer knowledge.



English

In English this term, we are studying the book 'A Rocketful of Space Poems' by John Foster and Korky Paul. Along with this, we will also be looking at a range of non-fiction books on space.

By the end of this term, the children will have created their own information text, persuasive advert and alien poem!



Mathematics

Over the next term, children will be focusing on statistics and graphs, fractions, decimals and percentages.

In their statistics unit, children will learn to read and interpret information in tables and line graphs.

In their fractions unit, children will learn to write proper fractions, improper fractions and mixed numbers, compare and order fractions, add and subtract fractions and multiply fractions by whole numbers.
