You must book in advance, Invoices are sent out a week in arrears and **must** be paid by the **Friday**.

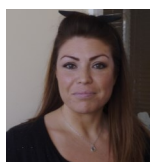
After School Clubs

Start of the day

Just a reminder that the school day starts at **8.45am**. Staff will be on the playground to supervise the children from **8.30am** and we therefore request that children do not arrive before this time unless attending the Breakfast club.

End of day procedures

The school gates will be open at 2.50pm. We are unable to allow parents to wait in the playground before this time as PE lessons are often still taking place.

Please can the **Year 2** parents wait for their child to be handed to them on the **top** playground at the end of the day and **not** take them out of the line as they go past.

For your child's safety, teachers need to be aware that the children have been picked up by the right parent/adult. Thank you for your co-operation.

Uniform

Uniform can be purchased from the office every day from 2.30p.m, to avoid queues in the morning. we will be happy to take your yellow order form with the payment and deliver the uniform to your child's class during the school day.

Naming your uniform

Please remember to name your child's uniform, we have too many lost items without names; some can be brand new. We recommend naming on the item itself not just the little label and if possible by using iron on labels - these can be purchased at Superstitch; £4 for 36 printed name labels which are ironed on and do not peel or wash off.
