Home Learning Term 5 and 6

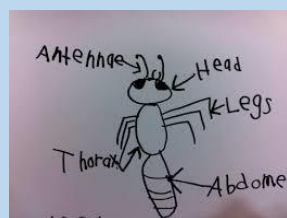
'Over in the Meadow'
